- Teams consist of 6 Student-Athletes and 3 Coaches
- Sessions occasionally include guest speakers and breakout activities
- Held at various businesses and public locations
- \$1,000 (min.) postsecondary scholarships are awarded to studentathletes following program completion. Over $\$ 545,000$ has been awarded!


## - OUR STUDENT-ATHLETES -

To date, 534 student-athletes have been selected for the Handshake America Program across four regions


- Coachable and gritty high school juniors
- Not necessarily the best athlete or highest GPA
- Desire to pursue post-secondary education
- Diverse ... we select one male and one female per school



## - OUR VOLUNTEER COACHES -

- Successful and respected people in the community
- Contribute a minimum of $\$ 1,000$ for student-athlete scholarships

## - OUR SCHOOL PARTNERS -

98 high schools across four program regions

1) Understand the Handshake America Program

## Where We've Been

Since 2011, Handshake America has been developing tomorrow's leaders by coaching them to embody our Five Practices of Success - Perseverance, Passion, Positivity, People, and Presence - inspired by John Wooden's "Pyramid of Success."

Our focused, yearlong program uses a team-based approach that enables meaningful coaching and provides postsecondary scholarships for high school student-athletes.

With a guiding hand, we help gritty, coachable young men and women from diverse backgrounds learn the elements and definition of "success" while leveraging the experiences and grit they gained through athletics. Even though they all come from diverse families, schools, and socioeconomic conditions, they all share common virtues. By connecting them with successful professionals, we break down walls between people and generations, show them that success is attainable, and reveal how the lessons from the playing field can be translated to success in all aspects of life.

To date, we have awarded more than $\$ 545,000$ in postsecondary scholarships to 462 gritty and coachable student-athletes in Ohio, Georgia, and North Carolina, who have gone on to enroll in 126 colleges in 25 states.

Our Teams, (3 coaches and 6 student-athletes) meet at various businesses throughout the year to work through our 5 Practices of Success curriculum. Typically hosted at our coaches' offices, these Team Sessions may also take place at other corporate locations, enhancing their overall program experience by introducing them to various office settings.
