### - OUR STUDENT-ATHLETES -

To date, **534 student-athletes have been selected** for the Handshake America Program across four regions



- Coachable and gritty high school juniors
- Not necessarily the best athlete or highest GPA
- Desire to pursue post-secondary education
- Diverse ... we select one male and one female per school



### - OUR SCHOOL PARTNERS -

98 high schools across four program regions

### 1) Understand the Handshake America Program

- Scholarship and coaching program for the "gritty" & "coachable" student-athletes
- "Coaching" vs. "Mentoring" Requires engagement from the student (comparison in Appendix)

### 2) Communicate the Program to School Representatives (teachers, coaches, counselors, or administrators)


- Focus on representatives who understand "grit and coachability"


- Teams consist of 6 Student-Athletes and 3 Coaches




### - STUDENT-ATHLETE APPLICATIONS -

### - TOTAL STUDENT-ATHLETES SELECTED -




